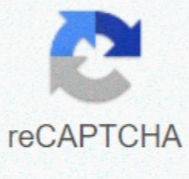

Curve analysis for SAT March 2020 USA exam: Reading - the overall difficulty is slightly greater than that of the International version main due to mainly due to two science passages. You can expect 10 points off for 1 mistake, 20 points off for 2-3 mistakes, and 40 points off for 4 mistakes. Writing/Grammar - the overall difficulty of writing/grammar normal. As always, the curve is steeper and you need to be meticulous. You can expect 10 points off for 1 mistake, 30 points off for 2 mistake, 40 points off for 3 mistakes. Math - "Heart of algebra" is relatively difficulty; students lacking a solid foundation may be prone to making mistakes. "problem solving" and "passport to advanced math" are of normal difficulty. Curve analysis for SAT March 2020 International exam: Reading - The overall difficulty is moderate mainly due to the comparatively easier passages. Two passages were written in 1930 about Franklin Roosevelt's foreign policy - they are easier to understand. For the first 3 mistakes, 10 points off for each mistake. For the fourth to the eighth mistakes, 10 points off for every 2 mistakes. Given the lower difficulty of the reading section, the curve is normal. Grammar - overall difficulty is normal, there wasn't any arcane concept being tested. 10 points off for 1 mistake; 30 off points for 2 mistakes; 50 points off for 5 mistakes.
